Head

5. **Round 12:** *sc in next 2 sts, dec* (repeat 6 times) (12)
6. **Round 13:** *sc in next st, dec* (repeat 6 times) (6)
7. **Round 14-15:** sc in each st (6)
8. **Round 16:** *sc in next 2 sts, inc* (repeat 3 times) (9)
9. **Round 17:** sc in each st (9)
10. **Round 18:** *sc in next 2 sts, inc* (repeat 4 times) (13)
11. **Round 19:** sc in each st (13)

Beak

13. **Round 1:** 4 sc in a magic ring (4)
14. **Round 2:** 2 sc in each st (8)
15. **Round 3:** sc in each st (8)
16. **Round 4:** *sc in next st, dec* (repeat 4 times) (4)
17. **Round 5:** sl st in each st

Eyes

18. **Round 1:** 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
19. **Round 2:** 2 sc in each st (12)
20. **Round 3:** *sc in next 2 sts, dec* (repeat 6 times) (6)
21. **Round 4:** sl st in each st

Assembly

23. Sew the beak onto the head.

24. Sew the eyes onto the head.
25. Stuff the body and head.
26. Sew the head to the body.

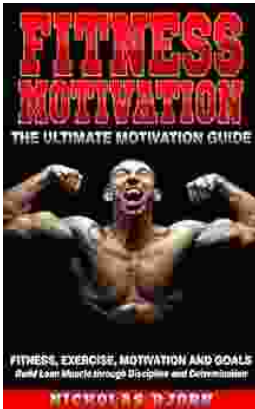
