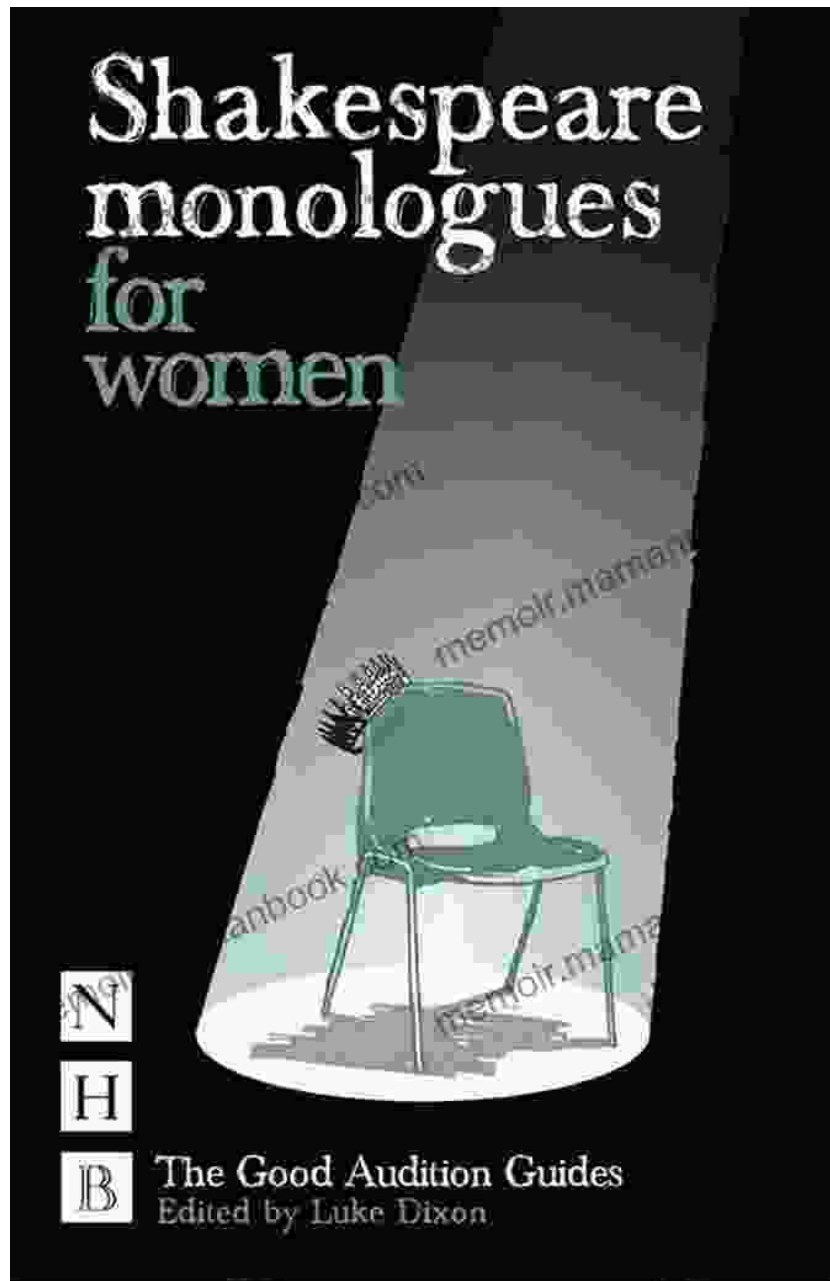
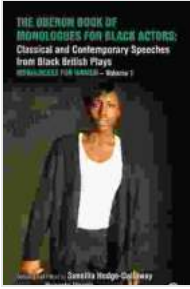


Image: Cover of 'Monologues for Women: Volume 2' from Oberon Modern Plays

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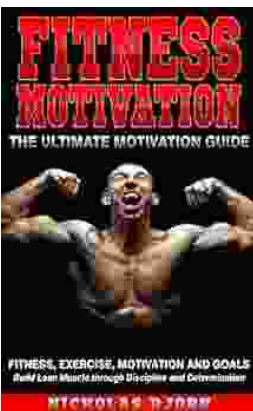


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George Gershwin's "Love You Porgy" from Porgy and Bess: A Timeless Ballad for Saxophone Quartet

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
